The Norfolk Town Board held a budget work session on Wednesday, September 14, 2016 at 06:00 PM at the Norfolk Town Hall.

Present were Supervisor Charles Pernice, Deputy Supervisor Robert Harvey, Councilman Donald Purvis, Councilwoman Jean Gang, Councilman Paul Paige and Budget Officer William Dashnaw.

Supervisor Pernice called the budget work session to order.

Mr. Dashnaw explained the workings of fund balance and contingency and reserve funds to the Board.

Supervisor Pernice noted that there is a new special district in the 2017 budget for the Cook St. Water Project. There is currently a Bond Anticipation Note in the amount of \$694,000.00.

Supervisor Pernice also noted that in the near future the Town of Norfolk will be providing water to the High School.
