PROPOSED RVs/Campers Moratorium

Planning Board Chair Kate Chepeleff shared the Planning Board's recommendation that the town place a Moratorium on RVs and Campers for the next 12 months in all zoning districts. Residents are turning these units into permanent residences and that is not what they are designed for. Town Code is being developed to address this situation.

Recommendations:

- No Permanent Water Hook Ups
- No Permanent Hard Wired Electrical Hook Ups
- No Enclosures with a Roof and Walls enclosing the RV or Camper or Structures that make the unit no longer movable.
