Supervisor Pernice called the meeting to order at 2:00 PM.

Public Comments:

- Brenda Paige said to tear the building down
- The contractor needs a special license to tear down and transport asbestos, as soon as there is a contractor available, they will get the building torn down
- The property will still be in the owner's name, and the bill will go to him
- Derek Stevenson from the Fire Department asked about keeping the street safe, they will have to spray the building with water during this process
- There will also be air monitoring
